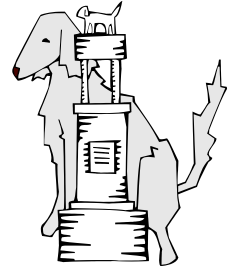

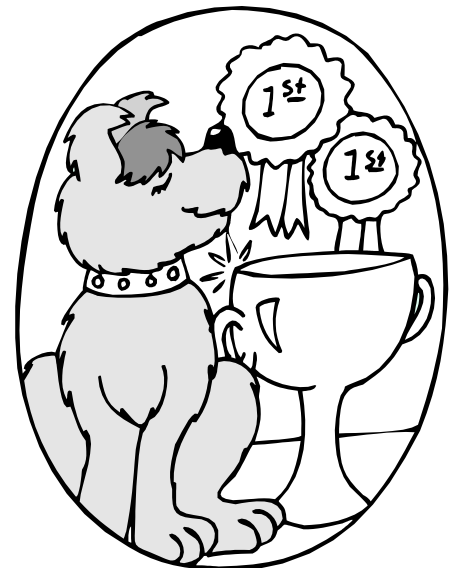

Award Qualifications:

- 1) All title(s) must be put on a handler-owned or co-owned dog who is a POC member.
- 2) The owner or co-owner must be a POC member at the time the title is earned.
- 3) The dog earning the title should live with the POC member the majority of the year.
- 4) Performance Title(s): All legs must be put on by a handler who is a POC member (except herding).
- 5) Breed Championship & Herding: A POC member or a professional handler may put the title on the dog.
- 6) The title(s) can be in obedience, rally-o, tracking, herding, hunting, flyball, breed, agility or other recognized dog sport.
- 7) One form PER DOG and please PRINT CLEARLY.
